

### **OL PEJETA CONSERVANCY**

The Ol Pejeta Conservancy is a mosaic of grass plains, wooded grassland, Acacia woodland and evergreen thicket extending for over 350 square kilometres. The Ol Pejeta Conservancy, East Africa's Largest Black Rhino Sanctuary, is situated at the foot hills of the Aberdares and the magnificent snow-capped Mount Kenya. Ol Pejeta boasts an astounding variety of animals including non-indigenous chimpanzees and the Big Five (the endangered black and white rhino, leopard, elephant, buffalo & lion). The combination of amazing wildlife and stunning views across the open plains guarantees an unforgettable safari experience.



### **ABERDARE NATIONAL PARK**

The Aberdare National Park in the central highlands of Kenya retains an air of mystery - you can only imagine what undiscovered creatures still lurk here, such as rare Black Leopards. The Aberdares are an isolated volcanic range that forms the eastern wall of the rift valley, running about 100 Km north south between Nairobi and Thompsons Falls. This beautifully scenic region is much cooler than the savannahs and offers a completely different perspective on the country. The national park lies mainly above the tree line. The scenery is spectacular with its mountainous terrain covered in thick tropical forests swathed in mist.



### **ITINERARY**

**Day 1:** Depart Nairobi for Nanyuki via Road after an early morning Breakfast. The Journey takes an approximate time of 3 to 4 hours. Arrive Nanyuki in time for Lunch. Check In. Lunch. Leisure at hotel. Dinner and Overnight

**Day 2:** Early morning Breakfast followed with a Game Drive. At 11.00am return to hotel, Leisure and Lunch. At 4.00pm depart for an evening Game Drive. Dinner and Overnight

The Aberdare Country Club, only a two and a half hour drive northeast from Nairobi, is nestled on a slope of Mweiga Hill in the Aberdare Highlands, part of the Great Rift Valley. This captivating site was the homestead of an English couple that decided to settle in Kenya. Almost a half century later, their home, "The Steep", was renamed the Aberdare Country Club and opened for guests.

Considered a heritage property in Kenya, The Aberdare Country Club has retained the charm of a private home with the simple comforts of a country inn. *"Today, despite the fast-changing tempo of the outside world, the old home still retains that comfortable, solid feeling based on traditions from a time when life proceeded at a far more leisurely and gentle pace."*

## THE ARK

Set in the heart of the Aberdare National Park, iconic and yes, quirky. The Ark overlooks a floodlit waterhole and salt lick, which attracts a host of awesome wildlife. Resembling and named after Noah's Ark, The Ark comprises of three decks from which numerous balconies and lounges provide a superb location for wildlife to be seen. So that you don't miss any animal sightings, the night guard will buzz your room when special animals come to the waterhole. The Ark has four viewing areas for observing the ever-present animal activity.

There is also a ground level bunker – the perfect hideout for the discerning photographer. This is a circular pillbox-like structure, and it is from this vantage point that pictures of animals on the salt lick only yards away may be taken through the view holes in complete safety.

**Kenya's Climate**

Generally the climate is warm and humid at the coast, cool and humid in the central highlands, and hot and dry in the north and east.

The relatively wet coastal belt along the Indian Ocean receives 1,000 mm or more rain per year. Most rain falls from April to July as a result of the southeasterly monsoon.

Rainfall peaks in most areas are in November and April. Some 30% of this zone can be classed as semi-desert, with rainfall averaging less than 300 mm per year and evaporation often greater than 3,000 mm.

**What to Pack -** It is advisable to travel with a small medical kit that includes any basic remedies you may need, such as antacids, painkillers, anti-histamines and cold remedies. You will also need anti-diarrhoea medication such as Imodium (adults only); and oral rehydration sachets such as Electrolade, especially if travelling with children.

**Yellow fever:** Certificate required for entry into, or travel between, some African countries.

**Terms and Conditions**

### **Payment terms**

1. 60 days prior to the departure date booking can be made with 30% advance.

4. Balance payment, if any, against all bookings shall have to be paid between 39-15 days before the start of tour.

### **Cancellation Policy:**

In case of cancellation, refund will be subject to retention of the amount from the date of start of tour in the following manner:-

- 10% if cancelled before 45 days
- 30% if cancelled between 29 days to 15 days
- 40% if cancelled before 14 days to 10 days
- 60% if cancelled before 9 days
- No refund if cancelled within or less than 9 days
